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2 Facilities of Weakley County Schools shall be named through Board action, based upon the
3 following criteria:
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- 5 1. This honor should be considered only for people who are deceased.
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 - 7 2. A person(s) should be considered only after receiving overwhelming endorsement from a
8 wide cross-section of the community. This endorsement may come from, but is not
9 restricted to, the following sources: city board, Parent-Teacher Organization (PTO),
10 booster club, and/or other appropriate local organizations. There should be no appreciable
11 opposition.

 - 13 3. A suitable plaque should be prominently displayed in recognition of the person so
14 honored. Appropriate ceremony should accompany this event.
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 - 16 4. A time limit should be set on the duration of the period over which the naming is
17 applicable. After some period of time (20 years, for example), the plaque may be
18 removed and presented, with an appropriate ceremony, to the family of the person
19 honored.

 - 21 5. Recommendations will be presented to the Weakley County Board of Education. A board
22 committee will review the recommendations and report to the board. The decision of the
23 Weakley County School Board is final.

 - 25 6. Naming school system facilities for individuals should be a very rare event.
