| CASE Assessment Benchmarks | ELA Math U.S. History | 2-10 (ELA) 2-11 (Math) 11 (USH) | December, April | Assess student learning as it progresses throughout the year. Identify areas of need so they can be addressed prior to students exiting the grade. | Results will be given to students to take home when received (two weeks or so after testing). They may also be distributed at January Parent-Teacher Conferences. |
| TCAP Achievement, TNReady | ELA Math Science Social Studies | 3-8 | Late April | Assesses student learning in the grade. Used for student grades and in evaluations for teachers, schools, and districts. | Scores used as a percentage of the student's grade. Performance reports attached to the first report card in the Fall. |
| TCAP End of Course, TNReady | Algebra I and II Geometry English I and II Biology I U.S. History | 9-12** | Late April | Assesses student learning in the course. Used for student grades and in evaluations for teachers, schools, and districts. | Scores used as a percentage of the student's grade. Performance reports attached to the first report card in the Fall. |
| ACT | English Skills Math Reading Science | 11 | March 12, April 2, or April 24 | Measures college readiness. Used in evaluations for schools and districts. | Results mailed home by College Board and reported to school counselors. |
| Aimsweb Screener | Reading Math | K-8 | September, January, May | Diagnostic; used to identify students who may need additional help in reading and math. | Teachers use results to inform their practice. Results are used in conjunction with other data to determine RTI2 placement. |
