A summer high school program may be organized and operated under the control and management of the Board of Education in compliance with rules and regulations 3 prescribed by the State and the local Board.¹ 4 5 2. For grades 1-8, a summer school shall be established only for removing deficiencies of 6 7 pupils and for providing enrichment. 8 9 3. Course credits may be earned in summer school. 10 4. Course credit may be earned in a traditional classroom setting or through non-traditional 11 avenues such as A+ Learning Systems and/or enrichment and remediation courses on the 12 13 internet. 14 5. All course credits received through non-traditional avenues must have prior approval of 15 the Director of Schools. 16 17 6. Attendance laws apply to students participating in any remedial instruction that is 18 19 required by the student's school, including summer programs and after-school instruction. The decision to require attendance shall be made by the principal who shall 20 consider the transportation available to the student (Public Chapter 219). 21 22 23 7.
