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- 2 Employees shall be physically capable of performing all professional responsibilities stated in
- 3 the job description. Employees shall inform the director of schools whenever they contract a
- 4 contagious or communicable disease.
- 5
- 6 No employee who has any communicable disease shall perform his/her duties in any location
- 7 where such might endanger the health of school children. The Board shall require any employee
- 8 to submit to a physical examination by a physician whenever there is reason to believe that the
- 9 employee has any communicable disease.¹
- 10
- 11 The director of schools shall reassign or suspend any employee who is suspected of having a
- 12 communicable disease which might endanger the health of children, pending investigation and
- 13 final disposition of the case before the Board.²
- 14
- 15 To assist the Board in making final disposition of the case, the director of schools may refer the
- 16 case to the County Health Office or other medical experts.
- 17
- 18 Employees holding a position which requires a CDL driver license are required to have annual
- 19 DOT physical. Individuals fifty-five (55) years of age or more are required to have as many DOT
- 20 physicals as requested by the supervisor of transportation. The Weakley County Board of
- 21 Education will pay the cost of DOT physicals provided by a physician with whom the system has
- 22 contracted. The only physicals accepted by the system will be with the physician with whom the
- 23 system has contracted. The supervisor of transportation will advise employees of the physician
- 24 currently under contract to provide these services.
