Closing and securing teacher work areas when being left unattended or at the end of the 6 7 2. Denying student permission to use the classrooms, laboratories, gymnasiums or other school facilities or equipment without appropriate faculty supervision; 8 9 3. Controlling the issuance of building keys and master keys; 10 4. Developing programs which contribute to the proper care and use of school facilities and equipment; and, 11 5.
